Why we need donations:

Warfighter Scuba is a 501(c)(3) organization and can be verified on the IRS website. Because we are a 501(c)(3) we require donations to pay for all expenses that occur from our programs. Our programs consist of Open Water certifications all the way up to Instructor for wounded Veterans. We help Veterans with PTSD and/or physical wounds from combat. It is in our belief that these Veterans are in need of activities that not only push them but help with our never ending journey to find adrenaline. Scuba diving is a safe and exciting opportunity that will allow these wounded Veterans to travel the world and experience amazing opportunities globally.

Operational costs per Warfighter Diver:

\$1,500 - \$2,000

This covers roundtrip airfare from the veterans home of record to Roatan.

\$1,400 - \$1,800

This covers the hotel stay on the island for 6 nights. Hotels will vary depending on what the occupancy is on the island.

\$300 - \$2,400

This covers the certification costs, such as training materials, dive charters, instructor/assistant/support costs.

\$500 - \$1,000

This is a buffer for any extra costs that may come up during the veterans 6 night stay on Roatan.

Total - \$3,700 - \$7,200

Please keep in mind these amounts are subject to change at any time. Costs of airfare change drastically as well as any special situations that need to be met on a per diver situation, i.e. special staffing for specific disabilities.
